What is Aging in Place?

18% of Winona County residents are age 65 or older, and 8% of residents under 65 live with a disability.

We know how much it means to you to live independently in your home.

That's why we partner with families, communities, and organizations to help people like you improve your home and quality of life so you can flourish right where you are.

We offer such updates as:

Who is eligible?

Aging in Place is a program designed specifically for Winona County residents who are at least 65 years old OR are living with a disability.

A home repair evaluation is done by a Habitat construction specialist in partnership with a social service professional. We will do a functional survey of your daily life and activities, health issues, and what you need to feel safe and confident in your home.

Criteria for Aging in Place services

1. **Clear need**
You must be at least 65 years old OR living with a disability AND have low to moderate income.
2. **Ability to pay**
We work on a sliding fee scale and can help you find alternative financing options.
3. **Willingness to partner**
Homeowners must be willing to contribute to the project in some way, such as writing thank you notes to volunteers or providing refreshments for workers.
